



## 2008 Flu Clinic Schedule

Cambridge residents (age 9 or older) can receive a free flu shot at any of the Cambridge Public Health Department's annual flu clinics. While there is no charge to the public for flu shots, seniors are encouraged to bring their Medicare health insurance cards with them to the clinics. The health department is able to bill Medicare and Medicare HMOs, which helps offset program costs. Pneumonia vaccine will also be available for adults over 65 years of age at all flu clinics.

**NEW!** This year the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) is recommending that **all children age 6 months to 18 years receive flu vaccine.** To respond to this need, the health department will provide flu vaccine to children as young as 24 months at the Tobin School clinic on Nov. 8. FluMist, a nasal spray vaccine for healthy children and young adults will be offered at this clinic.
